In 2009, all our students went on to UK universities including Cambridge, Oxford, UCL, Imperial, Southampton, Warwick and Nottingham



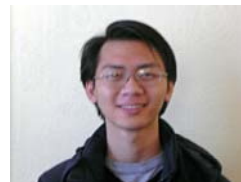
## INTERNATIONAL STUDY CENTRE (ISC)

Padworth ISC welcomes overseas students who need to improve their English for one or two terms before starting GCSE and A Level courses.

## UNIVERSITY ACCESS (FOUNDATION)

A one year course for students aged 17+ in Business with optional English Language tuition. This qualification acts as an acceptable entrance qualification instead of A Levels for a number of British Universities including Aston and Royal Holloway.
